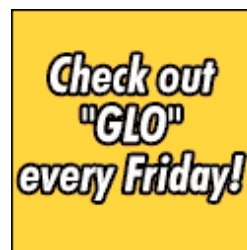

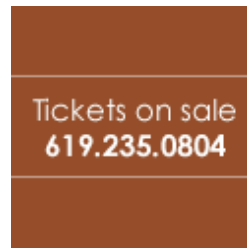
During baseball season, or any time of year, East Village and surrounding neighborhoods have plenty of fish tacos, margaritas and tasty apps to prep you for a night out.
